

SUPPORTIVE *AND* STRICT

If we claimed to be able to do behaviour management magic, you wouldn't believe us anyway. Human relationships are complicated but we believe there are some easy wins. By ensuring the behaviour of the vast majority of the pupils within the school is the best it can be, we take the first and most essential first step in tackling those hard to reach pupils.

We also know that different staff have different strengths. The teachers we liked at school were invariably really nice and really strict (and by strict, we mean consistent; you knew where you stood with them but you knew they liked you too). We'll be able to help your school and individual teachers increase consistency and 'niceness'. Pupils really want someone who cares enough to give them supportively applied limits.

NON-NEGOTIABLES

These are the routines, rituals and rules that everyone signs up to. We believe every school should have them and make them explicit. Not a big book of them; 2-sides of A4 will usually suffice. We've found that schools who agree on their expectations (and the language used to describe them) can save lots of time and make life much easier and happier for everyone. We can also help you to embed formalised emotion-coaching, giving you effective ways to repair and build relationships when they break down.
